

Working in Low Risk Confined Spaces

Course Overview

The Working in Low Risk Confined Spaces training course provides vital training to employers, employees and sub – contractors who are required to work in confined spaces (without escape breathing equipment). Low Risk areas can be described as having simple and clear access with adequate natural or mechanical ventilation

- Atmospheric Hazards and Gas detection methods
